An International Level Essay Writing Competition is being held as part of the commemoration of one hundred years of the demise of Hazrat Masih-i-Mauʻood, Mirza Ghulam Ahmad of Qadian. The purpose of the competition is to stimulate and encourage excellence in writing and research in the field of religious studies. Our goal is for members of the Jama'at to reach a deeper understanding and appreciation of matters relating to the Ahmadiyya Movement in general and the life, mission and achievements of its founder in particular. The competition is open to all members of the Worldwide Lahore Ahmadiyya Jama'at.

The competition will be held in two categories:

- Urdu
- English, Dutch and Indonesian

Each category is further divided into three levels

• Level 1: Age group up to 15 years

• Level 2: Age group 16 to 25 years

• Level 3: Age group over 26 years

There shall be one award in each category for each level (that is a total of six awards) as detailed below:

- Essays must not exceed the number of words specified for each level.

- The paper must be typed or neatly handwritten, double-spaced, with footnotes wherever applicable, on one side of white 8.5" x11" paper (A-4 size).
- First page must only show the title of the essay, author's name, name of the Branch Anjuman he belongs to, his complete postal and email addresses and phone number. Author's name must not appear anywhere on the paper in order to keep the author's identity anonymous; papers will be numbered for judging purposes.
- Title of the essay should be repeated at the top of the second page above the essay.
- Scholarly essays will be analytical and not merely descriptive and be properly documented with footnotes and endnotes, in accordance with general academic standards.
- Criteria of contest shall be scope of research, accuracy, creativity, conciseness, spelling, grammar, organisation, logical development of topic and original

critical/creative thinking. Credit will be given for originality of thought, a clear writing style, breadth of research and source materials (including books, web sites and other sources) and a critical approach to the sources used.

- To qualify for an award the essay must score an aggregate of at least 70% marks.
- All entries shall become the property of Ahmadiyya Anjuman Lahore. No entries will be returned.
- Only one entry will be accepted per member.
- Entries must reach the Central Anjuman by **15 January 2008**. Essays should be sent by registered/speed post to:
